



Yuba County Children's Council

The Yuba County Children's Council (YCCC) is a group of community and government leaders that meet monthly to plan, coordinate and impact the policies, practices and programs affecting children and their families in Yuba County. The YCCC serves as a policy and advisory body to the Yuba County Board of Supervisors and simultaneously serves as the executive Child Abuse Prevention Council (CAPC) for Yuba County. The strategic plan of the Yuba County Child Abuse Prevention Council (CAPC) is to:

- Enhance the credibility of child abuse prevention and the CAPC in the community;
- Build a better network of child abuse prevention-related partners;
- Strengthen the CAPC to be a more integral part of the YCCC;
- Ensure public awareness of child abuse issues and the resources available to prevent and intervene, including supporting, developing, and implementing other services and activities
- Train professionals and the public regarding identification, prevention, and treatment of child abuse and neglect.

The YCCC also coordinates a service provider level in the form of 10 Functional Groups that also meet monthly and focus on specific categories. Listed according to their Functional Group leadership, membership of the 2012 Yuba County Children's Council includes:
